- Planning and pre-launch of new Community Matchbox collaboration








University Network for Human Rights

- Established in 1939, WESU is one of the first and longest running student owned FM radio stations!

- Over 17,000 public service announcements broadcast each year!
- 120 hours of unique programming, broadcast weekly, from Wesleyan students, staff, faculty, alumni, and community volunteers.
- 26 hrs of progressive public affairs from Natonal, independent and local sources each week, including News by day from BBC, NPR, and Pacifica!
- WESU raises over \$50,000 in community support each year!
- WESU's staff and program reflect the diversity of the communities we serve on and off campus throughout the Central CT River valley and beyond!


